International Baccalaureate Diploma Scholarship

Kormilda is pleased to make a scholarship available to students who will be studying the IB Diploma at Kormilda College in Year 11 in the next academic year. Scholarships valued at 50% of the basic tuition fee to study the globally acclaimed International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma.

Successful applicants will be required to attend Kormilda and commit to undertake the IB as Year 11 and 12 students in 2016-17 as a condition of the scholarship.

To be considered for this special opportunity, we require interested Year 10 students to register for the ACER Scholarship test .

Also they will submit 500-800 words in support of their application describing why the International Baccalaureate Diploma will support their future goals. Use details of career path, how the course you have chosen will enhance your study goals, beyond Kormilda College

Entry Scholarships - Academic

These scholarships are available for new students who will begin Year 7 to Year 11 in the following year. All applicants will sit online ACER tests. These are the steps to follow: Go to www.kormilda.nt.edu.au Under Enrolment go to Scholarships Click on the ACER Login to Register for the test.

All-Rounder Scholarships

A limited number of All-Rounder Scholarships are offered to students from Year 7 to Year 11 whose contribution to their school and community in general would be significant.

Candidates who are interested in this scholarship will be required to submit a portfolio, which demonstrates their skills; leadership achievements and

contribution to their community at their current school. Also a handwritten letter of introduction is required.

All Academic and All-Rounder Scholarships attract a 50% basic tuition fee reduction. The academic progress of students is reviewed annually and determines the continuation of the scholarship.

After deciding on the appropriate Scholarship:

29 March 2016

- » Register online from the link provided for ACER tests. This applies to International Baccalaureate Diploma and Entry Level Academic Scholarships

20 May 2016

- » Registrations close midnight

26 May 2016

- » Submit Portfolio for the All-Rounder Scholarship and the Essay (Written Submission) for International Baccalaureate Diploma Scholarship to admin@kormilda.nt.edu.au for the attention on Ms Fay Gurr

4 June 2016

- » Sit the ACER Scholarship exams at the College. Information will be sent to you
- » Applicants will be sent notification of the outcome of this process
- » Sign the letter of acceptance and return to the College within 14 days
- » All applicants are advised of the outcome of this process.
- » Following an offer of a scholarship the acceptance letter is signed and returned to the College within 14 days.
